Tribe Trackmen Take Two Wins

The 1962 track season is now well under way, for the Indians have already recorded two victories in their first three meets.

The first of this three-meet series was held at home against Hood River. The season being young, it was scheduled as a three-quarters meet. Every running event was only three-fourths its normal length.

Starting the meet off to victory for The Dalles were Gary Morioka and Mike Fitzgerald who placed first and second in the 100 yd. dash. Morioka's winning time was 11.4 seconds. At the same moment K.C. Kortge, our Senior high jumper, was securing the high jump contest with a jump of 5'3". Overall, The Dalles trackmen won first in eight of the fourteen events.

The Jayvees, although losing 57-54 did quite well with top showings by Joe Petroff, Chris Martin, Gary Confer, Bob Loftin, Tom Davis and Tom Merriam.

Next after traveling to the Willamette Relays in Salem, the Indians went to Reynolds for their second win. The final score was The Dalles 90, Reynolds, 28. For this meet our boys of the cinders took firsts in all but 2 of the fourteen events. Doing outstanding jobs were Gary Morioka, Ken Bailey, Randy Martin, Gary Ordway, and Ron Rowland, all first-place winners.

The Jayvees also won their meet, with Larry Glenn doing the outstanding job of the day by taking first in both the 100 yr. dash and the 200.
