Pendleton Wins Wa-Hi Relays; Records Set

The Dalles took a first place in the mile team race and missed tying for first in the two-mile relay by one-tenth of a second during the Wa-Hi Relays at Walla Walla Friday.

A first and third place finish gave the Indians the team race. Harry Skandara, who won it, was clocked in in 4:42.1 while Lynn Harmon, finishing third, was timed in 4:44.3.

Although the Indians bettered a two-year old mark in the two-mile relay, they finished second to Pasco. Pasco broke the yarn in 8:35.4 while the Indians, composed of Gary Smith (2:10.5), Jack Miller (2:12.4), Bob Shaw (2:08.4) and John Merriss (2:04.2), were just one tenth of a second off the pace. They were clocked in 8:35.5.

Merriss, in turning in a 2:04.2, did not break his school record of a year ago—2:06.0. Says Coach Al Miller, "He had a running start."

The powerful Pendleton Buckaroos won the meet with 54½ points. Kennewick was second with 42, followed by Pasco 41, Wa-Hi 32½, The Dalles 27, Hermiston 20, La Grande 19 and Mac-Hi 8.

This Friday, the Indians are at home hosting a triangular meet with Hermiston and Redmond. The meet is scheduled at 4 p. m.
