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# Dalles Tracksters Surpass Earlier Marks

More late-season marks Coach Al Miller of The Dalles track and field teams has hoped for showed up again in Saturday's Bend Bulletin Invitational.

Although none of them were good enough to win the particular event, each Dalles mark was better than the individual has done in earlier season competition.

John Merriss, who bettered his last season mark with a 2:04.2 in the 800-yard run, Saturday ran the 800-meter run in 2:03.2. And in this event, Bob Thouvanel ran the same course in 2:07.8, his best.

Gary Ordway, finishing fifth in the 110-meter high hurdles, ran a 18.4, also his best. Sophomore John Allendorf, a fast comer in

the pole vault, turned in his best height of the season with a 10-6 to tie for second in that event, and Forrest Streb broad jumped 19-9½, his best effort, for a fifth in this event.

Although Ken Bailey didn't place in the discus throw, he bettered his previous mark by four feet, hurling the dish 130-2 feet.

Hosting Bend won the 10-school meet with 47½, followed by Crater 42, Redmond 38, Lakeview 25, Madras 23½, The Dalles 20, Prineville 7, Burns 5½, Wy'east 1 and Sisters 0.

This coming Saturday, the sub-district meet will be in The Dalles wherein four schools—Prineville, Bend, Redmond and The Dalles—will compete. And the following week, nine schools with representatives who get by the subdistrict meets will converge here to compete for berths in the state meet at Corvallis.
