Easterly Breaks Hood River Vault Record

Another school record was broken again Friday during the first annual Mid-Columbia Invitational track meet conducted in The Dalles.

This time, however, it was a Hood River High School mark and in the pole vault. Frank Easterly vaulted 11 feet, one-quarter inch, breaking Hood River's old mark of 11 feet.

Ironically, Steve Lawrence, The Dalles, set a new DHS record at Hood River Monday when he soared 11-7.

The Indians won the meet, garnering 108½ points, with Parkrose second at 92½ and Reynolds fifth with 24 among A-1 schools. Hood River was high for the A-2 school entrants with 61 points. Corbett was second with 42. B schools entered and not competing in all events were Cascade Locks and Maupin.

In the jayvee competition, it was The Dalles 99, Parkrose 80, Hood River 79½, Corbett 29, Reynolds, Maupin and Cascade Locks.

Scoring was based on the first five places in each event—8-6-4-2-1. The Dalles scored seven first places, Hood River and Parkrose had four firsts each and Reynolds and Cascade Locks one each.
