Bend Heavy Favorite In Subdistrict Meet

No matter how you look at the District 7-A1 sub-district track meet in Bend this Saturday and the district meet in The Dalles next weekend, the Bend Lava Bears look like they're going to gobble up most of the blue ribbons in both meets.

Strong in both running and field events, the central Oregonians showed their strength a few weeks ago when a busload of them walked away with the Class A-1 division of the Hayward Relays.

Coach Al Miller of The Dalles says the Indians contingent will leave for the subdistrict meet at

8 a. m. Saturday. Preliminaries in the 100 and 220-yard dashes and the hurdles will begin at 1 p. m., with the regular meet following immediately.

The subdistrict track meet in a sense is a preliminary, for only some of its entrants will compete in The Dalles next Saturday.

They are the first three finishers in both hurdles races, the 880-yard relay, and the first four in the 100 and 220-yard dashes. Other than that, it's the first five in each event.

While Bend hosts The Dalles, Madras, Redmond and Prineville, the eastern division schools of the Intermountain League plus Ontario are engaged in a subdistrict meet on La Grande's Eastern Oregon College oval.
