# Thinclads Eye Willamette

More than 1,200 athletes from 59 Oregon high schools and 25 colleges — including 28 from The Dalles — are expected to participate in the 14th annual edition of the Willamette Relays at Salem Saturday.

Feature events are the Statesman Mile, the Vern Gilmore 120-yard high hurdles and the Invitational 100-yard dash.

Dalles Coach Al Miller lists 10 lettermen among his 28 entrants, including seniors John Altendorf, pole vault; Loren Craber, javelin; Jack and Jerry Miller, broad jump; Harry Skandera, distance relays; and Tom Jones, sprints; juniors Larry Austin, middle distance relays; Doug Miller, sprints; Marnie Moore, discus and shot put; Gary Ordway, hurdles relays; and Bill Todd, javelin; and sophomore Phil Wagenblast, hurdles and high jump.

The thinclads will leave for the valley college site at 8 a.m. and return about 10 p.m.
