The Dalles Wins Track Meet Here

Six Mid-Columbia high schools took part in the Mid-Columbia Invitational at the Thompson Street track Friday.

Weather conditions were excellent, with bright, warm sun and no wind.

The Dalles, with the most participants, won with 108 points, followed by Goldendale 98, Hood River 64, Wy'east 41, Sherman 22 and Wahtonka 4.

Meet Director and DHS Coach Al Miller awarded trophies in the relays as well as ribbons for the first three places, and ribbon awards to the first five places in other events.

Goldendale, with a strong contingent in the running events in both varsity and jayvee competition, won the jayvee meet with 85½ points. The Dalles was second with 73, followed by Wy'east 71, Hood River 39, Sherman 14½ and Wahtonka 9.

Miller said none of the marks were outstanding but that an improvement was shown over the previous weekend's efforts at the Willamette Relays.

The Dalles travels to Wy'east next Friday and Wahtonka travels to Arlington Saturday.
