## Bend Easily Wins 7-A1 Meet At Hermiston

**HERMISTON** — Bend did the expected here Friday—win the District 7-A1 track meet going away.

The powerful Lava Bears took the lion's share of the blue ribbons and 30 district berths in the Oregon state prep track meet at Corvallis next Friday and Saturday.

They won five first places, five second places and took both first and second places in two events—440-yard dash and the discus throw.

And the Central Oregonians also have a district meet record breaker in Clyde Smith who put the shot 55 feet, eight and one-quarter inch, bettering the old mark of 53-2 $\frac{3}{4}$  by Bill Cook of Pendleton in 1960.

Two other records were set and a third was established. Harold Delamarter of Pendleton set a new standard in the mile with a 4:31.4 clocking, bettering 4:32.3 timing of Hermiston's Lee Melvin in 1963.

And Dick Hall of Pendleton set the other in the 880-yard run in 1:58.4, topping the standard of Bend's Herb Hickman of 2:05.0 in 1962.

Established mark is 9:48.1 in the two-mile run by Mac-Hi's Howard Kralman.

Bend mounted 134 points, followed by Pendleton 104, Ontario 40<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, Baker 36, Mac-Hi 36, The Dalles 30<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, Redmond 22, La Grande 19, Prineville 12 and Madras 8.

Pendleton took five first places and two second place ribbons, and swept the broad jump.

Interesting feature is that three runners will represent the district in the 880-yard run — the first and second place finishers in Hall of Pendleton; Harry Skandera of The Dalles, second; and Harold Delamarter of Pendleton. Delamarter also bettered the state meet qualifying standard of 2:00.0 (see story below).

Skandera, although running second, also bettered the old meet mark, and in addition set a new Dalles High School record with his 1:59.8 timing. His second place finish earns him a berth in the state meet.

The Dalles other state entrant is John Altendorf, who placed second in the pole vault with a 12-foot leap.

The first two finishers in each event are eligible to enter the state meet. The third place finisher in each event is an alternate.
