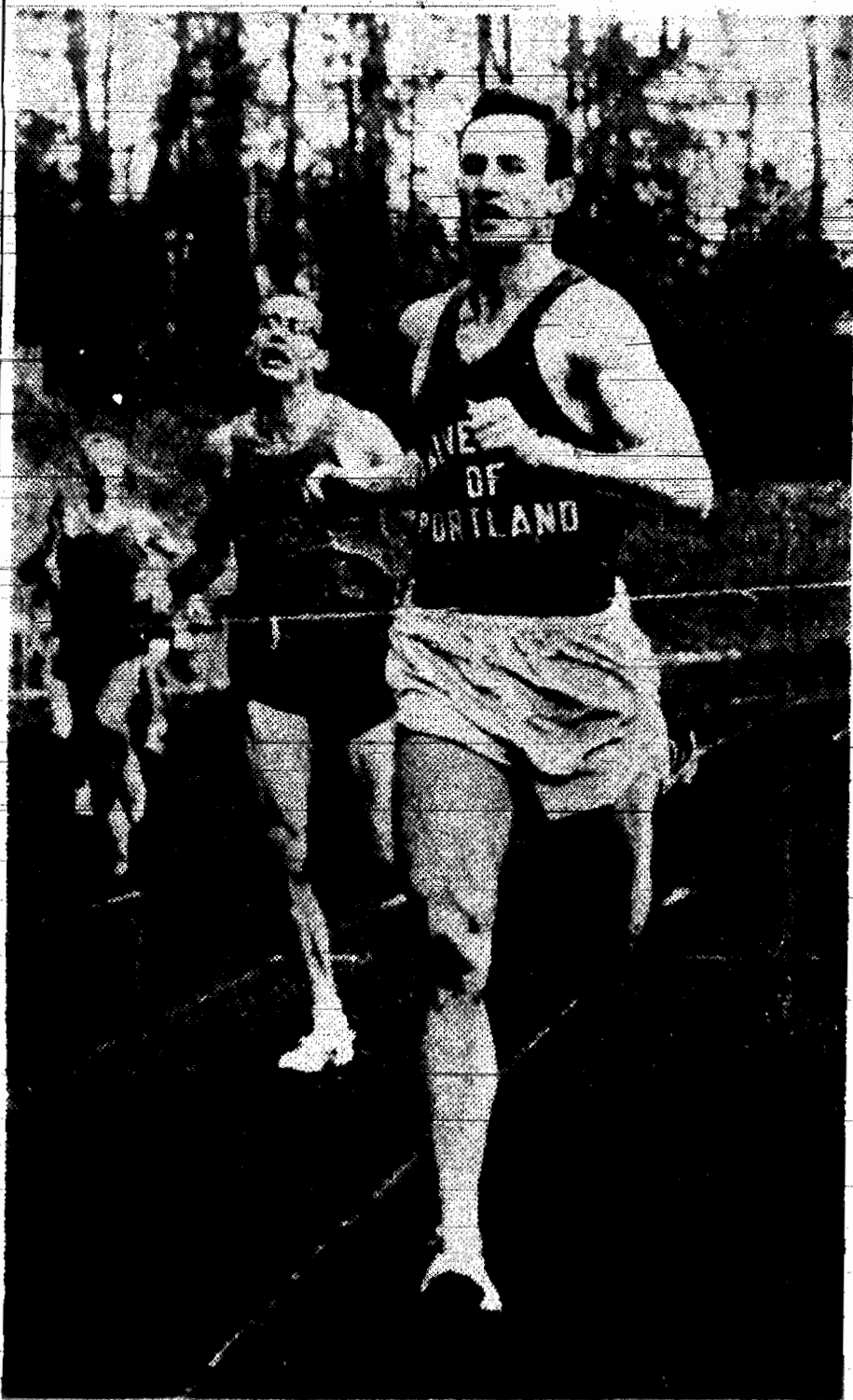

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Pilots' Big Wheel

Pilot Spikers

Roll Past L-C

University of Portland won all but four events and rolled past Lewis and Clark, 83-62, in a dual track and field meet at Palatine Hill Saturday.

The Pilots, led by Mike Boyle's four wins for $-21\frac{1}{4}$ points, missed only in the 880, mile, two-mile and mile relay, in posting their third dual meet victory of the season.

Despite Portland's near-monopoly on blue ribbons, the Pilots swept only the shot and long jump.

Boyle set dual meet records in winning the 440 and intermediate hurdles and ran a leg on a record-setting 440 relay team. Boyle also won the long jump and triple jump.

Portland's Mickey Toner and Lewis and Clark's Dan Acker each cleared 6-5 in the high jump, a record, but Toner earned the blue ribbon on fewer misses.

The fifth record fell to distance standout Chris Miller who toured the two-mile course in 9:30.3. He and teammate Ross Mouer shared the mile prize; Don Aaberg was

an easy winner in his 880 specialty and ran a leg on the mile relay.

UP's George Golightly, who led the 100 and 220 fields, was the meet's only other double winner.
