Pilot Thinclads Dump Falcons

Mike Boyle won five events, setting meet records in two and tying the mark in another, in leading University of Portland's track team past Seattle Pacific, 86-59, Saturday.

This was the final meet of the season for the Pilots, who finished with a 7-1 record.

Boyle lowered standards in the triple jump and 330-yard

intermediate hurdles and equaled the broad jump mark. He also won both sprints.

Allan Herald, set U of Portland and meet pole vault marks with his effort of 13 feet 8½ inches, and Mickey Toner, with his high jump of 6-6½, also set a meet mark.

Standouts for Seattle Pacific, which led through the first 10 events were Jim Ross, who ran the two-mile in 9:37.7,
