Radetich Tops Jump Record

OSU Rook Passes Standard By 5¼ Inches At Willamette

WILLAMETTE UNIVERSITY, Salem (Special) — Oregon State Rook John Radetich reached what might seem a dubious goal Saturday afternoon at the 17th running of the Willamette Relays.

He high jumped 6-9¾ to shatter the college freshman record by a whopping 5¼ inches, and Lewis and Clark yearling Tim Wright cleared 6-6 for second spot.

Radetich's achievement was simple. He equalled his high school best, but the circumstances behind it made it noteworthy.

"He was raising his head and going over the bar with his head way up in high school" OSU coach Berny Wagner noted. "We felt he would have to change to improve."

So Radetich altered his style.

"We started him practicing at low heights with a sweat shirt underneath the bar and made him keep his eye on it," Wagner said. "We've got him rolling now with a lower center of gravity."

The jumpers' efforts took a little of the edge off the three

feature events, which failed to produce records, although OSU newcomer Willie Turner overcame a poor start to come within a tenth of a second of the standard in the Oliver Huston Invitational 100-yard dash at 9.6.

Terry Thompson, competing for the Staters track and field club, ran away with the Statesman Mile prize in an easy 4:09.2. Thompson, who owns his own fishing boat at Newport and last summer cleared \$11,000, was never approached.

And John Lee of Whitworth defended his Vern Gilmore high hurdles title of last year in 14.6, well off his record-setting 14.3 of 1966.

Dyrol Burleson gave the fans a taste of his prowess by clicking off a 54-second final lap while anchoring Portland Track Club's victory in the college distance medley.

"I just want to keep in good shape," he commented. "I hope I can run a couple of miles under four minutes this year, then go for the Olympics in 1968."

Unofficially, his time was

4:10 after a slow 3:16 for three laps.

UNIVERSITY TWO-MILE RELAY — Portland Track Club with Don McMillan, Clark Santee, Danny Dean, Jerry Cound entered ran 7:48.6, paring nearly five seconds off old record.

COLLEGE TWO-MILE RELAY — Lewis and Clark with Bryan Laycoe, Jim Kennedy, Dave Schilling and Vern Jones running ran 7:58.3, better by 1.3 seconds.

FROSH TWO-MILE RELAY — OSU Rooks with Jim Palmateer, Ed Miller, Greg Hall and John Lilly posted 7:48.6, 19 seconds better than old frosh record.

FROSH MILE RELAY — OSU Rooks with Greg Hall, Ed Miller, John Lilly and Rod Paul running a registered 3:22.1, over two seconds faster than the old record.

UNIVERSITY POLE VAULT — Bob Glaeser of Oregon State soared to 15-2, erasing John Hergenrather's 1966 mark of 14-11. Hergenrather was second this time at 14-6.

Thompson, running his first outdoor mile this year in the Statesman race after a 4:09 in

the Oregon Indoor, "just ran to win."

"I felt easy through three laps but my back and the backs of my legs got pretty tight in the last 220 yards," he said. "I want to run the half when I start competing for Oregon State if possible, though."

His best at that distance is 1:48.6.

Lee was disappointed in his feature high hurdles effort. He got the lead off the fifth hurdle and was by himself after OSU's Craig Sonniksen straddled a hurdle and went out of the race.

There were some disappointments. OSU's Dick Fosbury, whose unorthodox upside down high jumping style has lifted him to 6-10, cleared 6-5 $\frac{3}{4}$ before stopping for fear of flipping out of the pit.
