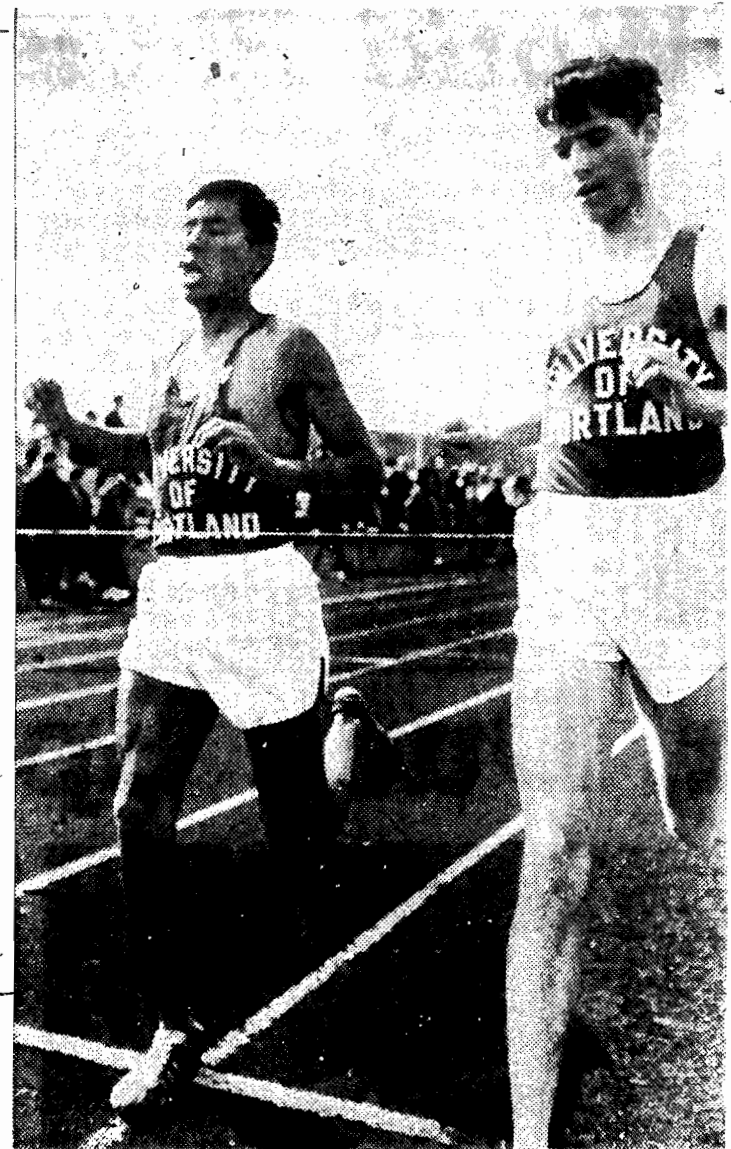

Evan Jaqua's 14.5 in the high hurdles also qualified as a mark in both categories. UP's Paul Kirkland (9.18.8 in two mile) and Tim Wright, LC, (45-10 in triple jump) established meet standards.

Lewis & Clark swept the top three spots in five events, but only three against competition. The Pilots failed to enter anyone in either hurdles event.

The meet was all tied at 43-43 through 10 events before the Pioneers scored back-to-back sweeps to pull away. The 1-2-3 finishes came in the uncontested intermediate hurdles and the triple jump. This gave LC a 61-43 advantage.

Portland's Mike Hryciw was the outstanding individual of the day in terms of endurance. Competing in five events, he won two (100 and 220), anchored the winning mile relay team, placed second in the long jump and third in the javelin.
